Louisville, KY (October 9, 2006) The Louisville Regional Airport Authority announces the following appointments:

Skip Miller, executive director, has been elected to the board of directors of Airports Council International—North America (ACI-NA) for a three-year term.

The ACI-NA Board of Directors is comprised of four officers elected annually and fourteen directors representing airports of various sizes across North America. Directors are elected annually on a rotating basis for a term of three-years.
