American Eagle Announces Significant Service Enhancements at Louisville International Airport

Louisville, KY (February 26, 2007)– American Eagle, a regional affiliate of American Airlines, recently announced enhancements to its Louisville International Airport service— including relocating its ticket counter and flights to new non-stop destinations.

In April, the ticket counter for American and American Eagle will be relocated from the west to the east side of the ticketing lobby—between Southwest and Delta Air Lines. The new location will provide more space for passengers and better meet the needs of an expanded flight schedule.

As part of the relocation, American Eagle will staff the ticket counter and ground-handling operations for American Airlines. (Previously, ExpressJet handled these functions for American in Louisville.) American and American Eagle flights will continue to operate from gate A14.

To fill these positions, American Eagle will host open interviews on February 26 and 27, 2007, at LaQuinta Inn and Suites. (More information is available at www.AmericanEagleCareers.com)

In addition, the airline has announced new non-stop service utilizing 37-50 seat regional jets:

- ➔ May 1, 2007—American Eagle will begin twice-daily service between Louisville and Raleigh-Durham, NC.

- ➔ September 5, 2007—American Eagle will begin twice-daily service between Louisville and New York’s LaGuardia Airport.

“We applaud American and American Eagle for their significant investment in our Louisville operation. We are confident that the business community will appreciate the new ticket counter location and expanded service options,” said Skip Miller, Executive Director for Louisville International Airport.

Currently, American and American Eagle offer 11 daily non-stop jet departures to Chicago, IL, Dallas/Ft. Worth, TX, and Miami, FL. With new service to Raleigh and New York, the airline’s flight schedule from Louisville will offer 24% more daily seats.
