Delta Air Lines Announces New Non-Stop Service To Boston, MA

Region Gains Non-Stop Access to Another Top Business Destination!

Louisville, KY (July 2, 2007) – Delta Air Lines today announced that it will launch daily non-stop jet service between Louisville International Airport and Boston’s Logan International Airport beginning September 6, 2007. The service will be operated by Delta Connection carrier, Comair, using a 50-seat Canadair regional jet.

“Over the last 18 months, the airport has worked directly with the business community to identify voids in service and increase access to the cities companies in our community visit most often. With this announcement, Delta and Delta Connection offer 19 daily departures from Louisville International to four non-stop destinations—Atlanta, Cincinnati, Orlando and Boston.

When this new service begins on September 6, 2007, Louisville International Airport will offer 110 daily departures to 29 non-stop destinations and convenient connections to hundreds of cities worldwide.
