

# Air Service is Taking Off at Louisville International Airport!

Recent announcements add three new destinations, a new airline and 18 new daily flights. Come join our growing numbers!



**Frontier Airlines (F9)** began non stop jet service to Denver on April 2, 2007. The airline utilizes 76-seat jets and provide connections to dozens of cities in the west, Canada and Mexico



**American Eagle (AA)** began two daily non stop jet flights to Raleigh-Durham on May 1, 2007. The airline utilizes 37-seat regional jets and provide connections to the Northeast and Florida.



**Midwest Connect (YX)** upgraded its two daily flights to Milwaukee from 19-seat turbo props to 32-seat jets on May 1, 2007. Midwest Connect provides frequent connections over Milwaukee to the West and Upper Midwest U.S.



**US Airways (US)** added a fourth daily flight to New York's LaGuardia Airport on June 4, 2007.



**Delta Air Lines (DL)** added one additional flight to Orlando on June 1, 2007. With this addition Delta offers three daily flights to Orlando.



**Southwest Airlines (WN)** added one additional flight to Orlando and one additional flight to Tampa on July 17, 2007. This addition doubles the airline's offerings to the popular Florida destinations.



**American Eagle (AA)** added two daily non stop jet flights to New York's LaGuardia Airport on September 5, 2007.



**Delta Air Lines (DL)** added one daily flight to Boston, MA on September 6, 2007. This is a new destination for Louisville and Delta Air Lines.
