Frontier Airlines Announces Plans to Discontinue Louisville Service

Louisville, KY (June 20, 2008)—Frontier Airlines recently notified the Louisville Regional Airport Authority that the airline will cease operations in Louisville on August 26, 2008.

Frontier began service to Louisville in April 2007, and operates two daily nonstop flights (114-seat Airbus) to Denver, giving it a 3.37% market share at Louisville International. The airline will continue its full schedule until August 26, and work directly with passengers impacted by the schedule changes to accommodate their travel plans.

Skip Miller, Executive Director of the Airport Authority noted, "These are constantly changing and very challenging times for the airline industry. The financial impact of high fuel costs has caused many airlines to rework their business plans and reduce flights and routes."

On April 10, 2008, Frontier Airlines Holdings, Inc. filed voluntary petitions for reorganization under Chapter 11 of the U.S. Bankruptcy Code, in the Southern District of New York.
