Midwest Airlines Resumes Nonstop Service to Milwaukee

Louisville, KY (June 11, 2009)–Midwest Airlines today announced plans to resume* daily nonstop service from Louisville International Airport to Milwaukee, WI, beginning August 2, 2009. The airline will operate the service using 37-seat, Embraer-135 regional jet aircraft.

“We have been working with Midwest Airlines to resume its popular service to Milwaukee for quite some time and are thrilled Midwest has decided to place Louisville on its expanding route map,” said Skip Miller, Executive Director for the Louisville Regional Airport Authority.
