United Airlines Begins New Nonstop Service From Louisville to Denver

Region Gains New Nonstop Destination and Improved Access to the West

Louisville, KY (December 17, 2009) United Airlines today launched daily, nonstop jet service between Louisville International Airport (SDF) and Denver International Airport (DEN). The service, operated by United Express carrier SkyWest Airlines, uses a 50-seat Canadair Regional Jet. However, due to the positive community response to the service, the airline plans to upgrade to a larger 66-seat aircraft (featuring first-class seating) in April 2010.

“This nonstop flight to Denver opens air service to the west coast for Louisville International travelers—a key growth market. Denver also is one of our region’s most popular business and leisure destinations,” Mayor Jerry Abramson said.

“For more than a year, the airport has worked directly with the business community and our airline partners to re-establish nonstop service to Denver. This new service, unusual in today’s aviation industry, is a critical element to our community’s success,” said Phil Lynch, Chairman of the Louisville Regional Airport Authority board.

With this announcement, United Express will offer seven daily jet departures from Louisville—including six flights to Chicago-O’Hare and one flight to Denver. With the addition of this nonstop service to Denver, Louisville International will provide nonstop service to 25 destinations—including 17 of the region’s top 20 most frequented cities.
