Flight Status Update

Louisville, KY (February 20, 2015) –Recent weather forecasts calling for ice and snow accumulations in Louisville, KY this evening have led airlines at Louisville International Airport to proactively cancel some incoming flights tonight and outgoing flights tomorrow morning.
