Who	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The Louisville Regional Airport Authority’s contractor—C and S Engineering—under the FAA-sponsored Aircraft Noise Mitigation Program
What	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Acoustical testing of various campus buildings, involving the amplification of periodic, static-sounding noise—about 100 dBs (equivalent to the noise of a chain saw, lawn mower or shop vacuum) will be heard throughout the campus. In addition, testing personnel will enter and exit the buildings to collect the test results.
Where	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Various buildings on the U of L’s Belknap Campus (see list below).
Why	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> As part of its commitment to the FAA in the Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) for the Louisville Airport Improvement Program (LAIP), the Airport Authority is working with the U of L to develop plans to minimize aircraft noise in eligible buildings on the University’s Belknap Campus, just north of Louisville International Airport’s (SDF) West Parallel Runway (17R/35L).
