Airport Authority Celebrates First Year of ‘SDF Cares’

LOUISVILLE, KY (April 18, 2018) –The Louisville Regional Airport Authority is proud to announce a successful first year of its SDF Cares program. SDF Cares is an organization-wide giving program that encourages and fosters opportunities for Airport Authority staff to volunteer their time with local organizations and events in the community and region. The program celebrates its one-year anniversary in conjunction with Louisville Mayor Greg Fischer’s Give A Day Week of Service.

In its first year, nearly 50 employees participated in SDF Cares, giving more than 540 total hours of their time to nearly 40 organizations and community events.
