Kentucky Bourbon Now Sold at Louisville International Airport

Louisville, KY (December 21, 2017) – Travelers at Louisville International Airport (SDF) now have another option to take home a piece of the Bluegrass – their own bottle of Kentucky bourbon. Package liquor sales recently began at the airport, with a variety of local Kentucky distilled spirits available for purchase at the Distillery District Marketplace, conveniently located in the rotunda beyond the security checkpoint.
