Dear Bowman Field Neighbor:

Today, the LRAA Board was briefed on the status of the Bowman Field Airport Area Safety Program. As part of the Environmental Assessment (EA), two companion documents have been submitted to the FAA, which the FAA will forward to appropriate agencies for review. These are the preliminary draft EA and the cultural resources evaluation element of the EA.

During the months of August and September 2014, the Hanson team conducted surveys and research of the affected environment. Once the data collection and research was completed, the process of drafting the environmental assessment document began and a preliminary draft of the environmental assessment has been sent to the FAA.

As a next step, the FAA will send the cultural resource evaluation to the Kentucky Heritage Council/State Historic Preservation Officer (SHPO) for review and input. The FAA and the Kentucky Heritage Council will together determine the next steps regarding the review of the cultural resource evaluation.

Other next steps in the process include:

- FAA completes review of the preliminary Draft EA document (Winter 2015)
- FAA's Draft EA available for public review to include a workshop (Spring 2015)
- FAA considers community and reviewing agencies' input and finalizes the EA document (Summer/Fall 2015)
- FAA issues findings
