



Expressive Activities

In the interest of public safety, airport security and efficient airport operations, the Louisville Regional Airport Authority offers individuals wishing to engage in Expressive Activities* at Louisville International Airport (SDF) or Bowman Field (LOU) a procedure to request a permit for such instances in the designated Speech Forum areas.

To request a permit, a written application must be submitted to the Airport Authority Executive Director Monday through Friday during normal business hours at least 48 hours prior to the time of the proposed activity that includes all pertinent information. *Please note, the Airport Authority considers Expressive Activities to include (but not limited to) conducting surveys, demonstrating and displaying signs, distributing written materials, making speeches, seeking petition signatures or otherwise communicating or attempting to communicate information to the general public on a non-emergency basis.
