Dear Bowman Field Neighbor:

We want to update you on our upcoming work to comply with the FAA's airspace requirements for Bowman Field.

The LRAA has now received an FAA grant for the Environmental Assessment (EA) part of the Bowman Field Airport Area Safety Program and has issued a Notice to Proceed to Hanson. We anticipate that this Environmental Assessment phase of the program will take about 10-12 months.

One of the first elements of the FAA's Environmental Assessment is field work and data collection. This work will begin Wednesday, August 6, and is expected to be completed in 45 days.

As part of the documentation and assessment process, arborists, landscape designers and others will be conducting field work in the residential and recreational areas in the vicinity of Bowman Field. Fieldwork will include visual inspection and photography.

Most if not all the necessary data can be obtained from streets and sidewalks, but as we've noted in the past, all project staff working in the neighborhoods will have identification badges and if for some reason we need access to private property, we will seek permission in advance of our visit.
