Re: Update to our October 21, 2015 letter announcing maintenance tree-trimming and/or removal for critical approaches to Bowman Field **on LRAA property, on properties with existing aviation easements and on public right-of-ways as permitted by Louisville Metro**

Dear Bowman Field Neighbor:

As you may recall, in October 2015 we announced the maintenance effort (managed by Hanson, Inc.) as outlined above.

The first part of the effort included a review of obstructions to the runway approaches on the following:

Off of Runway 6: Seven airport-owned parcels and 20 existing aviation easements located on properties on Drayton Dr. and Landor Ave. between Taylorsville and Denham Rds.

Off of Runway 33: One airport-owned parcel along Taylorsville Rd. and three existing aviation easements located on properties on Kent Rd. and Seneca Blvd.

Hanson worked with the property owners over which the Airport has aviation easements and with Louisville Metro to develop trimming and/or removal plans. The agreed-upon work was bid in early January, and a contract awarded to Louisville Paving, with the Bob Ray Company as the tree-trimming and/or removal subcontractor. Work is expected to begin the week of February 8, and be completed in late winter/early spring.

During this time, you may see the contractor, Hanson and LRAA staff in the neighborhoods—all will have IDs and/or be wearing uniforms. In addition, Pee Wee Reese Rd. may be used as a staging area and to access the backyards of homes on Drayton.

In addition, Hanson will work with the property owners whose trees are being removed to develop tree replacement and landscaping plans for this spring and early summer.
