The meeting was called to order at 6:00 p.m. by John Sistarenik. The March 23, 2015 meeting minutes were reviewed and accepted by Verna Goately and seconded by Pat Gould.

Part 150 NCP:

A. <u>Updates</u>:

Phase 1, 2, 3A, 3A-1, 4A, 4B and 5: Sound insulation is complete. To date 384 of 688 families have received sound insulation.

Phase 6: Sound Insulation for 60 families. The project was advertised on March 9, 2014. Phase 6 was awarded at the April 2014 Board meeting. Construction is underway.

Phase 7: Sound Insulation for 66 families. The project advertised on May 4, 2014. Contract was awarded at the June 2014 board meeting. Construction is underway.

Phase 7LC: Sound Insulation for 32 families located in phases 3A-7. The project advertised on October 5, 2014. The contract was awarded at the November 2014 Board meeting.

Phase 3B: Awaiting easement resolution. Audubon Park has filed an appeal.

Our current priority is to complete the remaining homes by the September 30, 2015 deadline.

B. Contraflow Exceptions: Contraflow for March was 71% for arrivals from the south and 66% for departures to the south. In April, arrivals from south were 53% and departures to the south were 77%. A daily summary for March and April is contained in the handout. As of May 1, 2015 arrivals from the south are averaging 67% and departures to the south average 74%. The 2 year average for arrivals from the south is 70% and departures to the south average 81%. A monthly summary going back 8 years is also included in the handout.

Current Noise Concerns:

- **A.** Report on Noise Concerns/Complaints: We received a total of 20 comments in March. 8 comments were received at the QHP project office and 12 were received by the LRAA. In April we received a total of 19 comments. 6 were received at the QHP project office and 13 were received by the LRAA.
- **B.** Runway Utilization: Runway utilization percentages for March and April are contained in the handout. Daily runway utilization for March and April as well as comments from the Air Traffic Control Tower for March are also included in the handout. Due to the early meeting date the operations count for April is not available until the 20th of the month.
- C. <u>Construction and Maintenance Activity</u>: Brian Sinnwell announced that the 11-29 Runway Safety Area project started May 4th and should be concluded in November 2015. Impacts to the airfield are closures to RW 11-29 and some other minor closures to the west runway. This project requires the construction of a tunnel which will require blasting of the solid rock in that location. Blasting will occur on the west side of the airport during the afternoon between the hours of 1:00 PM-2:00 PM on weekdays only.

Announcements: Bob Slattery called the groups attention to a press release from the FAA regarding a survey they will be conducting about airport noise. The FAA is undertaking a multi-year effort to update the scientific evidence on the relationship between aircraft noise exposure and its effects on communities around airports. The noise annoyance survey will be sent out to communities in the vicinity of 20 U.S. Airports. In order not to bias the survey results, the FAA does not plan to publish the list of airports. This study will likely conclude in early-to-mid 2016, with results analyzed and published in late 2016 or early 2017.

Guest Comments: Chet Heim recently purchased a home in the area and at the present time is not eligible for noise insulation. He wanted to know if there will be an opportunity in the future for him to qualify. Bob Slattery answered that we are following the FAA guidelines and we are limited to what areas qualify for mitigation. Bob offered to discuss further with him after the meeting. John Sistarenik informed Mr. Heim that state legislation is in the works to provide homeowners who do not qualify for sound insulation program reimbursement in the form of a state tax credit if they choose to sound insulate their own homes.


Brian Sandmann said that he is in the process of expanding his home and wants to know what type of improvements he should do regarding sound insulation of his home and if in the future his home may qualify for the program. Bob directed Mr. Sandmann to the QuieterHome project office for non-eligible homeowner information. Bob also explained that the Noise Exposure Maps get updated periodically. Typically, Noise Exposure Maps are good for 5 years. The current Maps are good until 2016. At this time we cannot project if the areas will expand, contract, or stay about the same.

Vic Korfhage wanted to know, regarding the legislation, if there was anything neighbors could do as a group to express their opinions. John suggested that he give his information to Mary Rose Evans who is the president of the Airport Neighbors Alliance (ANA).


Monthly Contraflow May 1-29, 2015

Monthly Contraflow June 1-30, 2015






Preferred Flow


Comment Type* (SDF and LOU)




Operations (SDF)






