- **I.** Call to order: The meeting was called to order at 6:00 p.m. by John Sistarenik.
- **II. Minutes:** The November meeting notes were approved as written.

#### III. Part 150 NCP:


- A. Noise Insulation Program: Residential A draft program boundary and acoustical test plan have been submitted to the FAA for their review. Program policies and procedures are in-work. Once all required approvals are received and funding has been secured we will be ready to roll the program out to public and begin the process of notifying homeowners. UofL On January 22, the FAA said that the Environmental Assessment should be wrapped up soon. It is expected that they will be issuing a Finding of No Significant Impact (FONSI). Currently, the plan is to begin designs in February for Life Sciences (room 101), Paul B. Lutz Hall, and Overseers Honors House. No on campus work is planned at this time.
- **B.** Contraflow Exceptions: Contraflow for November was 76% for arrivals from the south and 54% for departures to the south. In December, arrivals from the south were 72% and departures to the south were 61%. A daily summary for November and December is contained in the handout. For calendar year 2018 arrivals from the south were 72% and departures to the south were 75%. The 2 year average (January 2017- December 2018) for contraflow is 73% for arrivals and 75% for departures. A monthly summary going back 8 years is also included in the handout.

#### IV. Current Noise Concerns:

**A.** Report on Noise Concerns/Complaints: A total of 20 comments were received in November. Most were related to departures to the north. In December a total of 9 comments were received. All known locations were north of the airport. Comments and locations are contained in the handout.

- **B.** Runway Utilization: Runway utilization percentages for November and December are contained in the handout. Daily runway utilization and comments from the Air Traffic Control Tower are also included in the handout. Mary Rose Evans wanted to know at what point would an increase in operations trigger a recalculation of the Noise Exposure Maps (NEMs). Bob Slattery responded that he is not aware of a specific number or percentage increase that would necessitate an update to the NEMs. These numbers are being monitored closely and extensive operational forecasting will be completed as part of the ongoing Master Plan Update. The airport will take a close look at what that study is projecting for future operations.
- C. Construction and Maintenance Activity: Brian Sinnwell reported that there are no major construction projects underway at this time. John Greathouse asked who is responsible for the maintenance on the Woodlawn overpass. Brian responded that the road belongs to Metro Government and the airport is aware of issues and has been in discussions with Metro. Currently, the airport cannot get asphalt due to the weather. As the weather warms the Airport Authority will either fix it outright or fix it with help from Metro.
- V. 2019 CNF Report: A draft copy of the 2019 CNF report was provided to members for their review. John Sistarenik will present the report to the LRAA Board at its March meeting. John asked the group to review and let him or Bob Slattery know if they have any comments or corrections. Mary Rose made a motion that the report be approved pending comments received within the next two weeks. The motion was seconded by Mike Zanone. The motion was approved with all in favor.
- VI. Guest Comments: State Representative Lisa Willner gave the group an update on the status of House Bill 122 (HB122). This bill would establish a refundable tax credit for the cost of mitigating noise from a commercial airport for homeowners within the DNL 60 or higher contour and not eligible for the airport's noise mitigation program. She asked the group to call their State Representative and voice support for this legislation. State Representative Donohue also asked the group to support this legislation. He will send information on the bill to Bob Slattery so he can forward it to CNF members and community members who request it. Councilwoman Nicole George informed the group that public works was aware of the issue regarding the Woodlawn overpass and monitoring it. Bill Graham asked about the status of the test flight procedures the group had been working on with UPS. Bob Slattery informed the group that his understanding is that procedures are still in process however he is unsure of what impact, if any the partial government shutdown may have on the timing of implementing the test procedures.
- **VII. Announcements:** John urged the group to contact the LRC line to voice support for HB122.

# Monthly Contraflow January 1-31, 2019




# Monthly Contraflow February 1-28, 2019












#### **Average Daily Operation by Category**



- Air Carrier. (AC) Aircraft with seating capacity of more than 60 seats or a maximum payload capacity of more than 18,000 pounds, carrying passengers or cargo for hire or compensation. This includes US and foreign-flagged carriers.
- Air Taxi. (AT) Aircraft designed to have a maximum seating capacity of 60 seats or less or a maximum payload capacity
  of 18,000 pounds or less, carrying passengers or cargo for hire or compensation.
- General Aviation. (GA) Takeoffs and landings of all civil aircraft, except for air carriers or air taxis.
- Military. (MIL) Operations by all classes of military takeoffs and landings at FAA and FTC facilities.
