- I. Call to order: The meeting was called to order at 6:00 p.m. by John Sistarenik. John introduced CNF members Stephanie Kimmel and Chris Younkin from the Air Traffic Control Tower, Aaron Rosenblum representing the northeast quadrant, and John Greathouse representing the southwest quadrant.
- **II. Minutes:** The January meeting notes were approved as written.
- III. Update Open SID's Flight Test: Jonathan Bonds of UPS informed the CNF that several issues including the government shutdown, personnel changes at UPS and senior management retirements at the FAA have delayed implementing the Open SID flight procedure test. Although he cannot commit to a specific date at this time, late summer or early fall does not appear to be an unreasonable target.

IV. Part 150 NCP:

A. Noise Insulation Program: Residential — A draft program boundary and acoustical test plan have been submitted to the FAA for their review. Once all required approvals are received and funding has been secured we will be ready to roll the program out to the public and begin the process of notifying homeowners. UofL - On March 1, 2019 the FAA issued a Finding of No Significant Impact (FONSI) for the University of Louisville noise mitigation project. The LRAA is currently moving forward with designs for the Life Sciences building (auditorium, room 101), Paul B. Lutz Hall (archive center), and Overseers Honors House (room 202). Ken Dietz informed the group that the University is very close to making a final determination on Miller Hall and Threkheld Hall. He expects to have a definitive answer in the next month or so. Mary Rose commented that the university should keep the noise environment in mind if new dormitories are constructed. Ken informed the group that the university does take noise reduction standards into consideration when designing all building.

B. Contraflow Exceptions: Contraflow for January was 75% for arrivals from the south and 69% for departures to the south. In February, arrivals from the south were 78% and departures to the south were 57%. A daily summary for January and February is contained in the handout. Currently for calendar year 2019 arrivals from the south are 77% and departures to the south are 64%. The 2 year average (March 2017 through February 2019) for contraflow is 74% for arrivals and 74% for departures. A monthly summary going back 8 years is also included in the handout. Aaron Rosenblum asked if the contraflow goal numbers were based on individual months. Bob explained that the goals are annual averages from the EIS. The NEM numbers are annual averages based on the previous 5 years of historical data.


V. Current Noise Concerns:

- **A.** Report on Noise Concerns/Complaints: A total of 17 comments were received in January. Several were concerning arrivals from the south 15-20 miles from the airport. In February a total of 24 comments were received. Weather and runway 29 approaches were contributing factors. Comments and locations are contained in the handout.
- **B.** Runway Utilization: Runway utilization percentages for January and February are contained in the handout. Daily runway utilization and comments from the Air Traffic Control Tower are also included in the handout. John Greathouse remarked that there seemed to excessive ground noise coming from the airport last night. Bob replied that he was not aware of any unusual activity but he would investigate.
- C. <u>Construction and Maintenance Activity</u>: Bob Slattery reported that there are no major construction projects underway at this time. Currently the west runway is closed on Monday and East runway is closed on Tuesdays for routine maintenance. Pavement rehabilitation and runway electrical work may necessitate some additional runway closures as the weather continues to improve. John Greathouse reported that the Woodlawn overpass work was taken care of.
- VI. Guest Comments: State Representative Lisa Willner informed the group that House Bill 122 (HB122) did not get a hearing this legislative session. She would like to get together with Mike Zanone, Mary Rose Evans, and Aaron Rosenblum after the meeting to discuss support from neighbor associations. Rachel Roarx announced that she works with council woman Nicole George and will be attending the CNF meetings. Mike Zanone asked John Sistarenik to consider asking the LRAA for support with the proposed noise legislation (HB122). John said that support would be requested prior to the next legislative session.
- VII. Announcements: Mary Rose announced that it was the last meeting for Ken Dietz and requested that the group thank Ken for his service on the CNF. Ken announced that he will be retiring on April 15. The process for filling his position is underway but not yet far enough along to announce a replacement.

VIII. Next Meeting: May 20, 2019

IX. Adjournment: A motion was made to adjourn the meeting at 6:31 p.m.


Monthly Contraflow March 1-29, 2019


Monthly Contraflow April 1-30, 2019








New Address/Comments per Month (SDF and LOU)






New Address/Comments per Month (SDF and LOU)



Comment Type (SDF and LOU) April 2019






Daily Runway Use Uncorrected (SDF) April 2019







Operations by Aircraft Category (SDF)




Average Daily Operation by Category



- Air Carrier. (AC) Aircraft with seating capacity of more than 60 seats or a maximum payload capacity of more than 18,000 pounds, carrying passengers or cargo for hire or compensation. This includes US and foreign-flagged carriers.
- Air Taxi. (AT) Aircraft designed to have a maximum seating capacity of 60 seats or less or a maximum payload capacity
 of 18,000 pounds or less, carrying passengers or cargo for hire or compensation.
- General Aviation. (GA) Takeoffs and landings of all civil aircraft, except for air carriers or air taxis.
- Military. (MIL) Operations by all classes of military takeoffs and landings at FAA and FTC facilities.
