Restaurants, Retail Shops, Parking and Other Services

The Louisville Muhammad Ali International Airport (SDF) remains open and operational for commercial passenger service. Below is current information about impacts to restaurants, retail shops and other services at SDF related to COVID-19 (coronavirus).

Restaurants and Food Outlets

- Following Executive Order from Kentucky Governor Andy Beshear, all food outlets temporarily suspended in-dining and offering seating areas as of Monday, March 16, 2020 until further notice. **Grab-and-go and carry-out service are available at the following locations daily for travelers and airport guests.**
