Restaurants, Retail Shops and Other Services at SDF

The Louisville Muhammad Ali International Airport (SDF) remains open and operational for commercial passenger service. Below is current information about impacts to restaurants, retail shops and other services at SDF related to COVID-19 (coronavirus).

Restaurants and Food Outlets

- Following Executive Order from Kentucky Governor Andy Beshear, all food outlets temporarily suspended in-dining and offering seating areas as of 6 p.m. on Monday, March 16, 2020 until further notice. **Grab-and-go and carry-out service are available at the following locations for travelers and airport guests.**

- **Full bar service remains available on a to-go basis** to travelers post security at Chili's Bar & Grill and Coals Artisan Pizza. Starbucks Evenings also offers to-go service for wine and select craft beers.
- As of Tuesday, March 17, 2020, Starbucks located immediately before the security checkpoint is open daily from 4 a.m. to midnight (12 a.m.). They are temporarily suspending 24-hour operations during this period.
- The Comfy Cow located immediately before the security checkpoint **temporarily closed** as of Monday, March 16, 2020.
- The Bourbon Academy Tasting Room located on the second level of the rotunda, near the entrances of Concourses A and B **temporarily closed** as of Wednesday, March 18, 2020.
- All other restaurants may be open with limited hours of operation.

 - Brooks Brothers - Located before the security checkpoint
 - Winner's Circle - Located in Baggage Claim
 - Brighton Collectibles - Located in the rotunda at the entrances of Concourses A and B

Parking

Valet parking has temporarily closed and suspended all operations as of Wednesday, March 18, 2020 until further notice.

The Express Shuttle Parking Lot is temporarily closed until further notice beginning at noon (12 p.m.) on Thursday, March 19, 2020.

Additional parking remains available in the airport's Parking Garage (Levels 2-4), Surface Lot and Credit Card Only Lot.
