Re: COVID-19 (Coronavirus) Positive Case

Today, Saturday, March 28, 2020, we were notified by Louisville Metro Public Health and Wellness (LMPHW) that an individual who works for TSA-KY at the Louisville Muhammad Ali International Airport (SDF) tested positive for COVID-19 (coronavirus). This individual last worked at SDF on Tuesday, March 24, 2020. Due to the nature of their job, they had very limited exposure to others. We remain committed to working with LMPHW, TSA and other supporting agencies as we move forward with this information.

We take health concerns seriously and follow the guidance provided by public health officials at the federal, state and local levels. And because of this, we felt it was imperative that we share this information with you directly as soon as possible. In addition, the Louisville Regional Airport Authority is in the process of arranging for a deep cleaning and sanitization as soon as possible of this individual's work area.
