The Louisville Muhammad Ali International Airport (SDF) remains opens and operational for commercial passenger service. Below is information about impacts to restaurants, retail shops and other services at SDF related to COVID-19 (coronavirus).

Restaurants and Food Outlets

 Following Executive Order from Kentucky Governor Andy Beshear, all food outlets temporarily suspended in-dining and seating areas until Friday, May 22. At this time, KFC and Starbucks Evenings will offer limited seating capacity of no more than 33% based on reopening directives from the state. Grab-and-go and carry-out service remain available at the following locations daily for travelers and airport guests.

Taxi Services

Taxi operator zTrip has installed a Taxi Butler in lieu of the traditional taxi starter to assist those who need a taxi for transport from SDF. The individual simply follows the directions on the sign by pressing the button once on the red Taxi Butler, and cabs in the area are alerted a pick-up in needed. The Taxi Butler then shows the individual that a taxi is en route and the estimated wait time.



Electric Cart Service

The electric cart that provides courtesy service for passengers between the security checkpoint to/from the gate areas temporarily ceased operation.

Additional wheelchairs will be available for those travelers who need assistance.

Information Booth

The Information Booth is open with virtual assistance from our volunteer Airport Ambassadors by live video feed. The volunteers, who are knowledgeable of the airport's operations and community, are able to assist travelers and other guests

with flight information, ground transportation and a variety of other information.

The Virtual Information Booth is currently open limited hours during the following:
